## Revelation 6

- The breaking of the First Seal begins the Tribulation Period, and the Second Coming of Christ ends the Tribulation Period.
  - o God will end man's rebellion against Him.

#### I. First Seal.

- A. Rise of the Anti-Christ.
  - 1. The Anti-Christ is a man.
    - a. 1John 2:22 Who is a liar but he who denies that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist who denies the Father and the Son.
    - b. Rev. 13:5 And he was given a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies.
    - c. Dan. 7:25 He shall speak pompous words against the Most High...and shall intend to change times and law.
  - 2. He will become a world leader.
    - a. Leading a ten nation confederation know as the "Revived Roman Empire".
    - b. Rev. 13:7 The dragon gave him his power, his throne, and great authority.
    - c. Rev. 13:8 All who dwell on the earth will worship him, whose names have not been written in the Book of Life of the Lamb...
  - 3. He will be attended by a man known as the "false Prophet".
    - a. He exercises the authority of the Anti-Christ and performs great signs.
  - 4. He will sign a seven year treaty with the Nation of Israel.
    - a. Daniel 9:27 Then he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week;
      - > We believe that he hill help the Jews to rebuild their temple.
        - a.) Temple is standing in Rev 11, Matt 24.
        - b.) This is the anticipation of religious Jews today.
    - b. He shall break his treaty with Israel.
      - Abomination of desolation.
  - 5. Jesus shall destroy the Anti-Christ at His second coming.
    - a. 2Thes. 2:8 The Lord will consume *him* with the breath of His mouth and destroy with the brightness of His coming.
- B. Jesus turns over the world to the Anti-Christ.
  - 1. This is justice in that they have rejected the true Christ.

## II. Second Seal

- A. Peace taken from the earth.
  - 1. 1Thes. 5:3 For when they say, "Peace and safety!" then sudden destruction comes upon them, as labor pains upon a pregnant woman. And they shall not escape.

## III. Third Seal

## A. Famine.

- 1. A denarius could buy 10 qt. of wheat, or 30 qr. of barley.
  - a. Only 1/10 of the worlds food supply is available.
  - b. A soldiers rations was 1 qt of wheat.
- 2. Why should God continue to supply food for the earth?
  - a. When God created the earth He provided food for us.
  - b. Psalm 104:14-15 He causes the grass to grow for the cattle, And vegetation for the service of man, That he may bring forth food from the earth,...and bread which strengthens man's heart.
  - c. Psalm 136 Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! ...Who gives food to all flesh, For His mercy endures forever.

#### **IV.** Fourth Seal.

## A. Death

- 1. Forth horse: Pale; a greenish yellow.
- 2. Hades or the place of departed souls:- grave, hell.
- B. Current Population is World 6,767,026,492 (U.S. census bureau) March 2009
  - 1. 1.7 billion people will die.
    - a. Sword, hunger, pestilences, beasts.

## V. Fifth Seal.

- A. Martyred saints.
  - 1. How long until you avenge?
    - a. Rev. 16:6 For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, And You have given them blood to drink. For it is their just due."

# **VI.** Sixth Seal

- A. Stars from heaven.
  - 1. The Barringer Crater, (Meteor Crater), located about 35 miles east of Flagstaff Arizona
    - a. The crater is 4,000 ft in diameter, and some 570 ft. deep. It is surrounded by a 150 ft high rim of rock, raised by the force of the impact.
    - b. Meteor is also called *falling star*, *shooting star*.
